- 7) Gebze Technical University (GTU) continues to be a solution partner in every sector our country needs with its quality education and modern research capabilities. In this context, on the occasion of World Farmers' Day on May 14, producers registered with the Gebze Chamber of Agriculture were hosted at the GTU's Institute of Biotechnology. Supported by Prof. Dr. Mustafa Türkmen from the Institute of Transportation Technologies and the Director of the Career Development Center, and Ayhan Pekşen, President of the Gebze Chamber of Agriculture, the event was attended by approximately 30 farmers producing in different neighborhoods of Gebze. Approximately 60 schoolaged students (ages 7-19) participated in the event, conducted by GTU academics Prof. Dr. Meral Elçi, Dr. Fatma Karaoğlu, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Mustafa Türkmen, Dr. Aişe Ünlü, and Dr. Merve Mocan. The event took place at the GTU Faculty of Architecture. The visiting students were divided into five groups based on their cognitive development, allowing them to explore their talents in various fields, from robotics to chemistry, mathematics to sports, and from art to music. Students received approximately 45 minutes of training in the workshops. The workshops and activities were coordinated by GTU Student Societies and GTU volunteers. - 11) This summer school provided an opportunity for mathematics undergraduate, preferably graduate, and doctoral students affected by the earthquakes on February 6, 2023, in 11 provinces (those residing in these provinces or studying at universities in these areas) to think, interact, and study mathematics in a free mathematical environment. The event presented new developments in the theory of rings and modules, one of the fundamental topics in abstract algebra, using Leavitt path algebras as an example. This allowed participants to gain insights into current research and results in this field, preparing the necessary groundwork for those interested in conducting research. The event was supported by Assoc. Prof. Dr. Ayten Koç through TÜBİTAK 2237A, and by Dr. Fatma Karaoğlu Ceyhan through the Turkish Mathematical Society and the London Mathematical Society, as well as contributions from the Informatics Valley. It was coordinated under the supervision of Prof. Dr. Hamza Menken, with Dr. Fatma Karaoğlu managing the website, applications, student communications, and financial matters,
