





GTU has organized an average of approximately 30 events (e.g., conferences, workshops, awareness-raising, practical training, etc.) on the subject of sustainability annum over the last 3 years.

GTU did not send data to GreenMetric in 2021. However, it has been carrying out sustainability-related events and activities in 2021. In this context, a total of 28 sustainability-themed events were held in the academic year 2021. On average, 30 sustainability-themed events were held at GTU in the last 3 years.

- 1. GTU Institute of Earth and Marine Sciences organised a field study in order to reveal the causes of the Mucilage (Sea Saliva) problem in the Marmara Sea and to develop solutions. Mucilage formation, which has started to be seen in the Marmara Sea since the winter months and has become an environmental problem by spreading to wider areas with the increase in temperature, attracts the attention of scientific circles as well as the public.
